

A copy of this EAP shall be held by all Coaching Staff at <u>ALL</u> Club Sessions. It should be a part of the safety brief prior to all training sessions and matches.

All clubs are required by the Football Association (FA) to have a medical emergency action plan (EAP) in place that is integral to the overall function of their club. The plan enclosed here details the standard operating procedures (SOP's) or protocols for the actions to be taken to ensure an effective medical response in the event of a player, member of staff, match official or spectator being injured or becoming ill whilst on the site of Sinclair United FC.

Prior to any activities taking place, it is imperative that **team managers and assistants** complete a pre-session brief and risk assessment to confirm the following is in place:

- 1. A level 1 qualified manager (emergency aid trained and CRC checked) and assistant (CRC checked) are in attendance to run the session.
- 2. A suitably stocked in date **First aid kit** is available along with your team up to date **medical matrix** and a **medicines tin** for storage of participants medicines (i.e inhalers) any player that does not have their prescribed medication with them **must** not be allowed to participate in the session.
- 3. Access to the **de-fibrillator** is available by opening the outside toilet with the **key** that can be obtained from the **key safe** located in the **changing room** on the **Emergency action board.**
- 4. Check the access lane is clear from obstructions and unlock the padlock to the double green gates using the access code (75570)
- 5. **Roles** must be allocated before the session for the following actions:
 - a. First Aider suitably qualified. (manger or assistant)
 - b. Someone to call emergency services.
 - c. Someone to meet the emergency services at the barrier at the end of the access lane and open the height restriction barrier (code 12012) (emergency services given access code also)
 - d. Someone to meet the emergency services at double green gates to direct them to the field.
- 6. All equipment to be used checked for safe operation i.e goal posts, player equipment and shin pads, any player without shin pads must not participate in the session.
- 7. Communicate effectively this action plan with any opposition officials prior to any game or session taking place.

In the event of an emergency act fast, keep calm and follow procedures

- Call emergency services 999 or 112 (from a mobile that will alert services of exact location) for Police, Fire & Ambulance
- Administer first aid where required de-fib located in outside toilet adjacent to the bowling green
- Designated person to access emergency code from **emergency key safe in changing room** and meet emergency services at the barrier at the bottom of the access lane
- Designated person to open double green gates to allow access to the playing field and direct the emergency services to the incident
- Follow instructions from emergency services as to any actions required
- Complete club incident report form and record any accidents in the accident book located in the changing room
